Understanding land ownership considering the economic, social, and cultural situation of women in Uganda

My PhD research focuses on women's land rights, highlighting the particular context and perspective of women in two Ugandan villages: Village S, located in Mukono District, Central Uganda, and Village N, located in Kamwenge District, Western Uganda. The perspective of women at the village level on their land tenure situation is contextualised to inform discussions on the implications of implementing (land) policies at the village level in a culturally diverse country like Uganda.
